HOW CAN YOU HELP?

Sleep in Heavenly Peace (SHP) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit that builds and delivers beds to children ages 3-17 who are sleeping in unwanted conditions such as a floor, sofa, or in a bed with parents or siblings.

Our Bed Build Days are the perfect event if you're looking for a service opportunity for your organization and will make a permanent difference in your own community. You can also join our delivery team and see the smiles on the children who receive their very own bed for the first time.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

DELIVERY TEAMS

Once the bed pieces are made, we schedule deliveries to approved applicants when volunteers are available. Before the scheduled delivery appointments, volunteer teams of 3 to 6 people rally at our staging location; load the required beds, mattresses, bedding, hardware and tools; and head out to deliver, assemble and make the beds. No special skills are required. Families or groups of friends can volunteer to do deliveries together while individuals can be paired with other volunteers. It's great to have women and children on delivery teams to connect with recipients. A typical delivery takes 1 ½ to 2 hours. Caution: Watching the joy on the face of a child receiving a bed can be habit forming!

BED BUILD DAYS

While sponsors of Bunk Build Days usually provide volunteers to build beds, we always need SHP volunteers to help set up and tear down the build lines as well as train the sponsor volunteers on how to perform the workstation tasks. When the sponsor can only provide a handful of people to help, we may need as many as 20 SHP volunteers to fully staff the build. Typical Build Days go from raw lumber to 10 bunks (20 beds) in less than four hours with about an hour of setup before and an hour of tear down after.

We especially appreciate volunteers who help with set up and tear down! No prior experience or special skills required!

SPREADING THE WORD

Because SHP is an all-volunteer, donor supported organization, volunteers enthusiastically spreading the word about what we do is critical to the success of our mission. Whether it's an email to friends, social media posts with pictures or videos, blog posts or simply talking to people in your sphere; it's super helpful when you let people know that we build and deliver beds, including mattresses, and bedding for children aged 3-17 who have no bed of their own. We depend entirely on volunteers and donations from individuals, businesses and organizations.

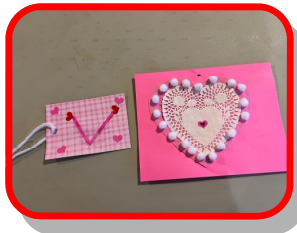
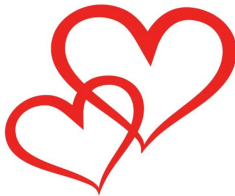
