A Message from your Pastor – September 15, 2024

Our lives can change in an instant, for good or for ill. I experienced one of those life changing moments last December sitting at the very desk where I am writing this message. I was working on an Advent peace sermon, and I did an internet search on the phrase "sleep in heavenly peace". I was expecting some articles about the favorite carol *Silent Night*. Instead I learned of an organization called Sleep in Heavenly Peace founded in Twin Falls, Idaho in 2012 whose mission is to build beds for kids who would otherwise be sleeping in the floor or on a sofa.

Before that December morning at Asheboro Friends I had no idea that this problem existed, let alone the scope of this problem. In the ensuing almost ten months I have seen the Lord working within me and so many people around me. I found myself traveling to Lehi, Utah for training. I have met so many caring and dedicated folks who take the words of Jesus from Matthew Chapter 25 as their mission. I have seen the Randolph County Chapter of Sleep in Heavenly Peace become a reality, and I am humbled to be serving as the first Chapter President.

I have seen what can only be miracles as our fledgling organization has been given the tools we need with a value of more than \$7,500.00, an enclosed trailer donated, and more than thirty individuals who have expressed their desire to become a part of this organization.

On Saturday, September 28, 2024 we plan to build the first beds to give to kids from 3 to 17 years old in Randolph County who are sleeping on the floor. I have many stories to tell, and I will have more in the coming months and years. I invite you to help in whatever ways you are willing, led, and able. Then you will have your own stories to share. If you can do nothing else, you can most certainly pray for this ministry.

### July Financial Report:




George Fox was born the son of a Leicestershire weaver in England in July 1624. He lived in times of social upheaval and war and founded the Religious Society of Friends. He travelled throughout Britain as a dissenting preacher, performed hundreds of healings, and was often persecuted by the disapproving authorities.

### Excerpt:

The Glorious Hope of Freedom

"Runaway slaves used frequently to conceal themselves in the woods and thickets in the vicinity of New Garden, waiting opportunities to make their escape to the North, and I generally learned their places of concealment and rendered them all the service in my power. My father, in common with other farmers in that part of the country, allowed



his hogs to run in the woods, and I often went out to feed them. My sack of corn generally contained supplies of bacon and corn bread for the slaves, and many a time I sat in the thickets with them as they hungrily devoured my bounty, and listened to the stories they told of hard masters and cruel treatment, or spoke in language, simple and rude, yet glowing with native eloquence, of the glorious hope of freedom which animated their spirits in the darkest hours, and sustained them under the sting of the lash.

These outlying slaves knew where I lived, and, when reduced to extremity of want or danger, often came to my room, in the silence and darkness of night, to obtain food or assistance. In my efforts to aid these fugitives I had a zealous coworker in my friend and cousin, Vestal Coffin, who was then, and continued to the time of his death—a few years later—a stanch friend to the slave.





Lloyd raises corn and soybeans on his farm in central Iowa. He and his wife, Charlotte, are active members of LeGrand Friends Church in Iowa Yearly Meeting. Lloyd has a passion to help people apply Christian principles in their business and workplace to impact the Kingdom of God.
